The LADES program is a preventive and intervention approach to empower young women with the knowledge, skills, and abilities to transition successfully from adolescence into womanhood. The program collaborates with community and educational leaders, local business partners and government agencies and will provide life skills training and workshops focusing on health and wellness, educational attainment, financial literacy, social issues, volunteerism, and self-esteem.

## **Fiscal Update**

Per Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc.'s Standard Operating Procedure, Section 9.800 (d) Fines and Penalties, Foundations are to submit a full disclosure financial report reflecting the information filed with the Internal Revenue Service to National Headquarters by April 1. SPEAR has submitted its proof of recording, along with our 2017-2018 financial report, to the sorority's national headquarters.

For Fiscal Year (FY) 2018, SPEAR had a community impact of \$26,150 through programming and donations.

At the 2014 Boule, the membership asked SPEAR to provide a breakdown of the SPEAR donations by region. As of January 31, 2019, SPEAR has received contributions totaling \$6,202.00 from graduate members of Central Region. In addition to this update, the SPEAR sends monthly reports to the regional leadership.
